Use turf and blueberry sod vegetation to cover bare areas on your property and prevent soil from being washed away, and help keep the lake clean and healthy!

Blueberry sod is a low maintenance ground cover that not only holds soil in place and soaks up runoff, it provides attractive flowers, beneficial wildlife habitat, and tasty berries!



Because sod is fully mature the day it is installed, it immediately controls erosion. Sod can be installed on steep hills and is used on slopes for stabilization.
